For Capstone Farm riders: this program is recommended for riders with little to no horse handling experience, and children who have participated in our beginner camp.

Program activities include learning to:

Groom, tack, and lead the horse, identify colors and markings, feed and care for the horses, muck stalls... And More!

Your child should bring a water bottle, and **boots** (if they are waterproof or heavy duty that's best). Your child should **dress for the outside temperature**. This includes warm coats, hats, gloves, and if necessary, long underwear. Children can take off layers as they warm up. We do have a heated space if the temperatures dictate it, but will also spend time in unheated areas.
